It Will Be Alright | Joshua 1:1–5

Level Up in Perspective

Key Verse

“No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you nor forsake you.” (Joshua 1:5, NASB)

Transition can be difficult. It can definitely be overwhelming. All that you can see ahead is challenges, obstacles, and opposition. It seems impossible. The benefit doesn't seem to outweigh the burden. What do you do? Do you give up before the battle begins, or do you rest on the assurances of God?

Joshua shows us exactly how to handle transition that presents these types of challenges. Moses has recently died, and he's been entrusted with the responsibility of leading God's people into the Promise Land. Imagine Joshua's current situation. He's young, he's uncertain, and could even possibly be unsure of every intricate detail of God's plan, but he trusts in God to lead him through this transition. Joshua is assured of this because God has promised him two amazing gifts: His promise and His presence. God has already ordained Joshua to lead in spite of difficulty and has guaranteed His presence in spite of doubts that may arise. With God's presence and God's promise, He can accomplish anything.

You may be wrestling with a major task today. It may seem as if you're incapable of fulfilling it, but ask yourself these questions: “Hasn't God already given me this task? Won't He and His promises empower me to accomplish it?” The answer is yes. God makes sure that we're alright even when things don't appear as if they're alright. Your present situation may not seem as if it's going to work in your favor, but God's promises guarantee a positive outcome in spite of a pessimistic outlook.

Strength For The Journey | Joshua 1:6–7

Level Up in Perspective

Key Verse

“Be strong and courageous... being careful to do according to all the law...” (Joshua 1:6–7)

There's a track term called “the second wind,” where a runner somehow musters an amount of strength in the midst of the race that mirrors the strength that they had at the beginning of the race. Whether this concept is psychological or physical, the runner finds the capacity to endure for a little while longer, if not for the duration of the race.

Joshua is perhaps overwhelmed by the tall task of leading God's people into the Promise Land, but he receives a spiritual “second wind” that gives him the strength that he needs to complete his mission. God tells Joshua to remain strong, be courageous, and lean on the promises of the Word of the Lord. As a result, he and his people would inherit the land. Those three key components would be all that he needed.

God is doing something big in your life, yet it seems as if it's too big for you. In your own strength, it is—but with Him, you have all that you need to seize every promise He has for you. Remember these things: be strong in Him, be boldly courageous, and never depart from the promises of His Word. God has given you the strength; you just have to fulfill the mission.

Level Up in Perspective

Key Verse

"Prepare your provisions... for within three days you are to pass over this Jordan to go in to take possession..."
(Joshua 1:11)

Companies often offer giveaways for prizes that have no strings attached. You don't have to pay for anything or incur hidden fees; the only requirement for obtaining the promised prize is following the instructions for receiving it. It's really that simple—at least it should be.

There are two foundational reasons why the Lord blesses us: His sovereign choice and our obedience. But unfortunately, obedience is often the difference between an obtained blessing and a delayed (or even denied) blessing.

Joshua presses this very point in his initial commands to his Israelite followers. He stresses that the Promised Land is a guaranteed reality for them, but in order to possess it, they would have to be completely obedient to the command of Joshua—who was ultimately receiving his orders from the Lord. The land is theirs; they just have to follow the process.

There are similar blessings that God has in store for us. The issue isn't God's willingness to give as much as it is our willingness to obey. And we can't pick and choose what part of God's plan we desire to obey; there's no such thing as partial obedience. But the good news is that when we obey all of His plan, He provides all of His promise. It's yours—follow His lead.

Working In The Background | Joshua 2:21–24

Level Up in Perspective

Key Verse

“So she said, ‘According to your words, so be it.’ So she sent them away, and they departed; and she tied the scarlet cord in the window.” (Joshua 2:21)

Often, some of the most amazing work is done in the background, not the forefront. There are many individuals behind the scenes who we never see, yet their impact is undeniable. We see what is done, yet are sometimes unaware of who's done it. In the scope of the Kingdom, God's work is impactful and powerful, but there are times when we don't realize it. He majors in working miracles from the background.

That's the case in Joshua 2. Rahab is a pivotal character in the grand scheme of God's plan, and the latter portion of this story highlights two parallels to the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ—disclosed in an Old Testament manner. The scarlet cord and the three-day waiting period are key components to the safety of the spies and Rahab's family. In a larger scope, this salvation ensures that Jericho will be secured by the Israelites. In the same way, Jesus' sacrifice and His three days in the grave are essential to our salvation. Even when He seems “behind the scenes” in the Old Testament, He is very much present—and the New Testament makes that unmistakably clear.

If we aren't looking for Jesus, we will miss Him in the background moments of our lives. He may seem inactive, but you can be assured that He is always active. While you're trying to figure it out, He's already worked it out.

Key Verse

"Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." (Joshua 3:5)

The day before a game, we would walk through alignments and coverages to ensure we were adequately prepared. It wasn't very strenuous physically, but it tested us mentally—so that we could execute physically. When we positioned ourselves properly the day before, it became a preview of good things to come.

Joshua is preparing the people for a successful next day, but in order for the success to be fruitful tomorrow, there must be proper alignment today. He urges them to consecrate themselves because the Lord has promised to do wonders among them as they prepare to cross the Jordan. In short: they should prepare themselves because God is preparing to do something amazing for them.

Most times, the difference between success and stagnation is alignment. When we are in sync with His plan, He has the freedom to lavish us with His richest promises. The promise is there; He's waiting on us to get in position to receive it. Today, remember: the closer you are to His person, the closer you are to His promise. Line up with Him—the result is amazing.

Children hold parents to promises like nobody else. They don't let you forget even the smallest commitment. But what strengthens trust even more is delivering on a promise without being reminded.

God isn't like us; nothing slips His mind. In Joshua 3:7, after Joshua encourages the people with God's promise, the Lord encourages Joshua with another promise: He will exalt Joshua in the sight of Israel and He will be with him just as He was with Moses. God will elevate him with power and accompany him with presence. Any mission can be completed with those two factors.

You may be facing an insurmountable task, but remember who gave you the assignment and what comes with it. God is with you just as He has been with others. You are not in this alone. There is no secret to what God can do—what He's done for others, He will do for you.

(Joshua 3:17, NASB)

I once drove through the community where I was raised and remembered the old dirt road that led to my childhood home. It still exists, but it has been replaced by a highway. As a boy, I wondered how they could build a highway on a different path and still lead to the same destination. I learned that skilled hands can make a way where there seems to be no way.

That's the picture in Joshua 3:17. The Jordan was at flood stage, yet Israel crosses on dry ground. No one argues with the conditions; they obey the Word of the Lord.

In our walk with God, we don't have to worry about how God is going to make a way. His supernatural promises trump natural predicaments. Whatever you're facing today, understand this: God doesn't have to figure out a way—He's already made the way.

Before Kindles and tablets, we read actual books—and we used bookmarks. A simple marker helped us remember where we left off and how far we'd come.

In Joshua 4, God gives Israel “spiritual bookmarks” through the stones placed as memorials after crossing the Jordan. These stones were not merely functional; they were testimonies. Every generation that saw them would know how far God brought His people and how faithful He remained—even when they weren't.

You may not have stones stacked by a river, but you do have reminders: a healed body, a saved child, a door God opened, a sin you overcame. Today, reflect on the moments when God brought you through what seemed impossible. You'll find reasons to bless His name.

Storytelling has been embedded into the fabric of our heritage. It keeps memory alive, inspires hope, and reminds the next generation that God is faithful.

That's the charge in Joshua 4:23–24. God dried up the Jordan like He dried up the Red Sea so that “all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of the Lord is mighty,” and so that God's people would fear the Lord forever. The miracle wasn't meant to end with the moment—it was meant to become a message.

Today, share your story. Let someone know you don't look like what you've been through. Tell them the God of Israel is your God too—and He is still working miracles.

“Then the Lord said to Joshua, ‘Today I have rolled away the disgrace of Egypt from you.’ So the name of that place is called Gilgal to this day.” (Joshua 5:9, NASB)

Opportunity doesn't always come knocking a second time—especially after disobedience. But Israel is living proof that God gives second chances.

Israel crosses the Jordan into a new season, and in Joshua 5:9 God declares that He has “rolled away the reproach of Egypt.” He brings them to Gilgal—meaning “circle.” They only come full circle because they are not the same people they used to be. They've grown, learned, and become more willing to obey.

Stay on the path of God's will despite the past. When you step onto the ground of your destiny, you'll discover you're there because you're better. Keep going—you're on your way to better.

In Joshua 5:15, the Commander of the Lord’s army tells Joshua to take off his sandals because the ground is holy. God is bracing Joshua for what’s next. The place of obedience becomes the place of encounter.

Long-Term Debt With High Interest | Joshua 7:10–12

Key Verse

“The Lord said to Joshua, ‘Stand up! Why is it that you have fallen on your face? Israel has sinned, and they have also violated My covenant... Therefore the sons of Israel cannot stand before their enemies.’” (Joshua 7:10–12, NASB)

Debt is costly—especially when it's accumulated as a knee-jerk “short-term fix.” Interest makes the final cost far greater than the original amount.

Sin works the same way. In Joshua 7:10–12, Israel's disobedience (through Achan) makes the whole nation unable to stand before their enemies. Hidden sin produced public weakness.

Sin always costs more than we intend to pay. But we thank God for Jesus—our High Priest—who paid a debt we could never satisfy. Today, don't ignore what God is exposing. Confession and obedience restore strength.

God isn't just the God of “one more chance”—He's the God of another chance.

After defeat at Ai, God gives Israel another opportunity for victory and then Joshua leads them into covenant renewal (Joshua 8:30–35). Grace isn't permission to stay the same; it's power to start again.

Here's the lesson: God recycles our mistakes when we repent and recommit. If you've taken a loss, turn back to God. He's still in the business of granting victory.
